Sprayer & Tractor Operator

The purpose of the role has a variety of different tasks, however one of the main responsibilities is the application of agricultural pesticides in a safe way in line with crop spray schedules. We envisage this to encompass around 40% of the role, mowing 30% and other growing related jobs 30%.

The role would be primary blueberry sprayer operator and secondary strawberry sprayer operator. We operate on two sites and expect you to cover both sites, as needed.

- Spraying blueberry & strawberry crops using Antonio Carraro tractors.
- Mowing blueberries across two sites.
- Weed spraying via tractor sprayer and knapsack.
- Deploying biological controls.
- Nematode applications via tractor applications.
- Blowing of gutters post-harvest crop
- Supervising teams doing growing related jobs.
- Other growing related jobs such as irrigation shots.
